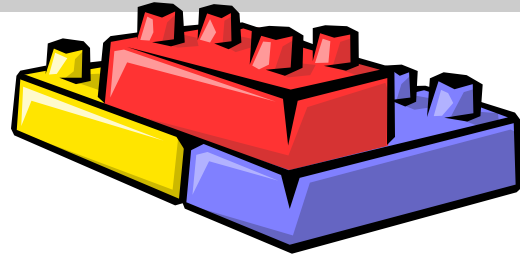


LEGO Design Contest 2009

Rules:

You must bring your own LEGO's to build your entry. No sharing of LEGO's will be permitted except for team members. You will be assigned a table upon which to build your original design. **No pre-assembling will be allowed this year.** Boxes and carrying bags of LEGOs will be examined at the door to ensure that everyone starts from the same dismantled stage. Should a box or carrying bag contain pre-assembled work, participant(s) will be asked to step aside and disassemble work before entering the Civic Center Ballroom. **No LEGO or Technic LEGO kits will be permitted.** You may however, use a special piece from a kit or use Technic LEGOs in your creation. It is the rebuilding of kits that is prohibited.

On the day of the event, Ballroom doors will open at 9 am, please find your assigned space and begin building. Then at 9:30 am, all unclaimed table space will be reassigned to any wait list participants. All contestants have until 2 pm to finish their original designs. At 2pm, all contestants will be asked to leave the Civic Center Ballroom for closed door the judging. If you finish early (before 2 pm) you may want to have your picture taken with your creation. The Ballroom doors are scheduled to reopen after the judging is complete or by 3 pm. Winners will be announced once the judging is complete.
